NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

CALIFORNIA UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT

The County of Sonoma invites all licensed contractors, who are willing to perform public works construction and/or repair projects up to an estimated \$200,000.00 to qualify/register their firm for inclusion on a list of registered bidders for the 2023 calendar year, in accordance with California Public Contract Code §22034 and all trades categories are subject to the informal bidding procedures as set forth by the State of California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA). Bid information regarding these projects will be sent to contractors registered on the County of Sonoma's Informal Bidding Pre-Qualified Contractors List at least ten (10) days prior to the bid due date.

You must resubmit to be included on the 2023 list even if your firm has previously submitted an application. All Contractors that are interested in being on the 2023 Informal Bidding Pre-Qualified Contractors List are required to have a current license, DIR registration, and insurance and are subject to verification.
