






Recommendations

1. Implement a collective-impact decision-making group for Sonoma County that owns the issue of homelessness in the community
 - Establish an ad-hoc task group to develop and evaluate various models for an effective collective-impact decision-making group to become the Board of the Continuum of Care.
 - Develop a transition plan for the various responsibilities held by existing decision-making groups.
 - Create and approve a guiding principles document that outlines high-level aspects for the systems including: standard performance outcomes, required best practices, and funding alignment.
 - Establish key task groups necessary for this group to operate effectively.

5. Approval of a Housing First Model by Primary Decision-Making Group
