

STATE SMALL WATER SYSTEMS WATER QUALITY EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION PLAN
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The California Health and Safety Code Chapter 4, Section 116460, requires all water utilities to have an **Emergency Notification Plan**. This plan is to be implemented whenever the Department of Health Services determines that your water supply fails to meet water quality standards and represents an imminent danger to the health of the water users. The notification must indicate the nature of the problem with the water supply. A representative of the state small water system and/or the owner or operator of the system must perform the notification.

Additionally, the California Health and Safety Code Chapter 14, Section 64212, requires the water supplier to notify Sonoma County Environmental Health within 48 hours of being notified of positive sample results for any routine or repeat bacteriological water sample that indicates total, fecal or Escherichia coliform presence.

To maintain current information on each water system, this office requests that the below information is completed and returned by April 1st of this year regardless of whether or not the information has changed.
