1. HMIS User Fee Policy Update (Action Item)- Daniel

- Summary- HMIS software user license costs continue to rise, and the system is expanding in terms of the number of users accessing it since 2018. DHS receives CoC funds for HMIS and staffing. These funds do not cover the costs of administering HMIS. HMIS participating providers already pay towards license costs as part of the CoC funding match process. To address the funding shortfall, the proposal is to limit to the number of licenses assigned to each HMIS participating provider.

Summary- The HMIS Data Committee has agreed to include updates on other Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) topics of interest as agendized items for ongoing review and discussion.
